Beekeeping Training Institute, Tabora invites applications from qualified applicants for admissions to Technical Certificate and Ordinary Diploma in Beekeeping for the 2017/2018 academic year.

A. COURSE OFFERED:-

- i. Basic Technician Certificate in Beekeeping One (1) year course (NTA Level 4)
- ii. Technician Certificate in Beekeeping: One (1) year course (NTA Level 5)
- iii. Ordinary Diploma in Beekeeping: One (1) year course (NTA Level 6)

B. ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

Basic Technician Certificate Course

i. Holder of Certificate of Secondary Education (CSEE) with at least four (4) passes i.e D grade or higher (One pass must be of Biology Subject)

OR

Certificate of Secondary Education from other countries with pass in biology subject and translated by NECTA.

OR

Possession of at least NVA Level III of Beekeeping/ Apiculture and completion of O-Level

Technician Certificate Course

i. Holder of Basic Technician Certificate (NTA Level 4) in; Beekeeping, Forestry, Forestry Industries, Wildlife, Agriculture or any other relevant fields of study from the recognized Institutions.

OR

Holder of Advanced Certificate of Secondary Education Examination (ACSEE) with at least one (1) principal pass and one (1) subsidiary pass in any of the following subjects; Biology, Chemistry, Agricultural Sciences, Basic Applied Mathematics, Geography or Physics.

OR

Advanced Certificate of Secondary Education from other countries with passes in science subjects and translated by NECTA.

Ordinary Diploma Course

i. Holder of Technician Certificate (NTA Level 5) in Beekeeping/Apiculture

C. TRAINING FEES:

Successful applicants will be required to pay training fee as follows:

Basic Technician Certificate, Technician Certificate Course and Ordinary Diploma Course Tsh. 805,000/= or USD\$ 2,100.00 for Non - Tanzanian Students.

Note:

- a. Training fee can be paid fully or on installment basis i.e. Half of the total fee at the beginning of semester I, another half at the beginning of semester II.
- b. The costs do not cover charges for breakfast, lunch, accommodation, students' field attachment/study tour and field working gears.
- c. Limited accommodation is available at the campus which cost Tsh 270,000/= per year (payable once or in two installments).

D. MODE OF APPLICATION

- i. Applicants applying directly to the institution are required to note the following:
- Applicants will be required to fill the application form costing TShs 20,000.00 (twenty thousand) for Tanzanians and USD 20.00 for foreigners as application fee.
- All applications must be accompanied by photocopies of certificates, bank slip and academic transcripts written in English or their English Translation. Applicants from outside Tanzania should attach NECTA translations of their results transcript.
