**INVITATION FOR APPLICATION FOR ADMISSION TO CERTIFICATE AND
DIPLOMA IN BEEKEEPING FOR THE 2018/2019 ACADEMIC YEAR**

Beekeeping Training Institute-Tabora invites applications from qualified applicants for admissions to Technical Certificate and Ordinary Diploma in Beekeeping for the 2018/2019 academic year.

A. COURSE OFFERED:-

- i. Technician Certificate in Beekeeping: Two (2) year course (NTA Level 5)
- ii. Ordinary Diploma in Beekeeping: Two (2) year course (NTA Level 6)

B. ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

Technician Certificate Course

- i. Holder of Certificate of Secondary Education (CSEE) with at least four (4) passes i.e D grade or higher (Among these passes one should be either in Biology or Geography or Chemistry or Physics or Agriculture Science)

OR

Certificate of Secondary Education from other countries with pass in science subjects and translated by the National Examination Council of Tanzania (NECTA).

OR

Possession of at least NVA Level III of Beekeeping/ Apiculture and completion of O-Level

Ordinary Diploma Course

- i. Holder of Advanced Certificate of Secondary Education Examination (ACSEE) with at least one (1) principal pass and one (1) subsidiary pass in any of the following subjects; Biology, Chemistry, Agricultural Sciences, Basic Applied Mathematics, Geography or Physics.

OR

Holder of Technician Certificate (NTA Level 5) in; Beekeeping, Forestry, Forestry Industries, Wildlife, Agriculture or any other relevant fields of study from the recognized Institutions.

OR

Advanced Certificate of Secondary Education from other countries with passes in science subjects and translated by NECTA.

C. TRAINING FEES:

Successful applicants will be required to pay training fee as follows:

- i. First Year: **Technician Certificate Course and Ordinary Diploma Course** Tsh. 816,000/= **or** USD\$ **1,380.00** for Non - Tanzanian applicants.
- ii. Second Year: **Technician Certificate Course and Ordinary Diploma Course** Tsh. 786,000/= as training fee **or** USD\$ **1,250.00** for Non – Tanzanian applicants.

Note:

- a. Training fee can be paid fully or on installment basis i.e. half of the total fee at the beginning of semester I, another half at the beginning of semester II.
- b. The costs do not cover charges for breakfast, lunch, accommodation, students' field attachment/study tour and field working gears.
- c. Limited accommodation is available at the campus which cost Tsh 270,000/= per year (payable once or in two installments).

D. MODE OF APPLICATION

- Applicants will be required to fill the application form costing TShs. 10,000.00 (ten thousand) for Tanzanians and USD 10.00 for foreigners as application fee.
- All applications must be accompanied by photocopies of certificates, bank slip and academic transcripts written in English or their English Translation. Applicants from outside Tanzania should attach NECTA translations of their results transcript.

E. DEADLINE
