**INVITATION FOR APPLICATION FOR ADMISSION TO CERTIFICATE AND  
DIPLOMA IN BEEKEEPING FOR THE 2021/2022 ACADEMIC YEAR**

The Principal, Beekeeping Training Institute-Tabora invites applications from qualified applicants for admissions to Technician Certificate and Ordinary Diploma in Beekeeping for the 2021/2022 academic year.

**A. COURSE OFFERED:**

- i. Technician Certificate in Beekeeping: Two (2) years programme (NTA Level 5)
- ii. Ordinary Diploma in Beekeeping: Two (2) years programme (NTA Level 6)
- iii. Ordinary Diploma in Beekeeping (Upgrading): One (1) year programme (NTA Level 6)

**B. ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS**

**Technician Certificate Course**

- i. Holder of Certificate of Secondary Education (CSEE) with atleast four (4) passes i.e D grade or higher (Among these passes one should be either in Biology or Geography or Chemistry or Physics or Agriculture Science)

**OR**

Certificate of Secondary Education from other countries with pass in science subjects accompanied with equivalent letter from National Examination Council of Tanzania (NECTA).

**OR**

Possession of atleast NVA Level III of Beekeeping/Apiculture and completion of O-Level

**Ordinary Diploma Course**

- i. Holder of Advanced Certificate of Secondary Education Examination (ACSEE) with at least one (1) principal pass and one (1) subsidiary pass in any of the following subjects; Biology, Chemistry, Agricultural Sciences, Basic Applied Mathematics, Geography or Physics.

**OR**

Holder of Technician Certificate (NTA Level 5) in Beekeeping **OR** Forestry **OR** Forestry Industries **OR** Wildlife **OR** Agriculture **OR** any other relevant fields of study from the recognized Institutions.

**OR**

Advanced Certificate of Secondary Education from other countries with passes in science subjects accompanied by Award Evaluation letter from National Council of Technical Education (NACTE).

### C. TRAINING FEES:

Successful applicants will be required to pay training fee as follows:

- i. First Year: **Technician Certificate Course and Ordinary Diploma Course:** Tsh. 816,000/= as training fees **or** USD\$ **1,380.00** for Non - Tanzanian applicants.
- ii. Second Year: **Technician Certificate Course and Ordinary Diploma Course.** Tsh. 786,000/= as training fees **or** USD\$**1,250.00** for Non – Tanzanian applicants.
- iii. **Ordinary diploma (Upgrading):** Tsh. 826,000/= as training fees

#### Note:

- a. Training fee can be paid fully or on installment basis i.e. half of the total fee at the beginning of semester I, another half at the beginning of semester II.
- b. The costs do not cover charges for breakfast, lunch, accommodation, students' field attachment/study tour and field working gears.
- c. Limited accommodation is available at the campus which cost Tsh 270,000/= per year (payable once or in two installments).

### D. MODE OF APPLICATION AND DEADLINE

- i. Applicants will be required to fill the application form with attached application fee deposit slip of TShs. 10,000.00 (ten thousand) for Tanzanians or USD 10.00 for foreigners as application fee.
- ii. All applications must be accompanied by photocopies of certificates, bank slip and academic transcripts written in English or their English Translation. Foreign Applicants should attach Equivalent Letter of their results transcript from NECTA.

- iv. All applications should be sent to the Institute via institute email or postal address or by hand or via online applications.
- v. All applications must be sent to the Institute not later than 14<sup>th</sup> August 2021. Late applications will not be considered.
